Role	To provide supervision of the pool, ensuring the safety of all customers is maintained at all times and regulations are adhered to.

Your duties:

1. Maintaining a safe pool environment through excellent lifeguarding practices
2. Deliver excellent customer service and swimmer experience
3. Ensure safe provision of all equipment
4. Assist with equipment setting up and packing away. Ensure this is done safely and notify the managing director/coordinator of any broken or damaged equipment
5. Maintain your own training records and provide Core Aquatics with your monthly training record
6. Ensuring all customers adhere to the pool rules at all times
7. To be a positive role model for swimmers
8. To attend meetings with the managing director and other members of the Core Team when required
9. To agree and abide by a code of conduct and carry out duties in accordance with Core Aquatics procedures policies, wavepower, safeguarding children, health and safety at work, etc
